## **PROPOSAL:**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approving a one-year contract continuation with AT&T for Plexar service, and waive competitive bidding due to sole source provisions. Only a one year contract is recommended while our I.T. Assessment Group (Plante & Moran) evaluate our complete telecommunications infrastructure to determine our future plans for telecommunications services.

## **BUDGET IMPACT:**

Various funding sources and budget programs cover this expenditure, allocated proportionately to their usage of the service. The total budget impact city wide is \$91,200.00.

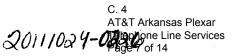
