# **DESCRIPTION:**


This is a proposal to name an alley. The purpose is to help emergency responders to locate residential units that are accessed from an alley. This alley extends between Center Street and Dickson Street, and paralell with School Ave (see attached Map)

A RESOLUTION TO NAME THE ALLEY THAT RUNS FROM DICKSON STREET SOUTH TOWARD CENTER STREET BETWEEN SCHOOL AVENUE AND LOCUST AVENUE FOR 911 PURPOSES "MIDTOWN ALLEY"

WHEREAS, some residential structures have been built behind houses in the three blocks between School Avenue and Locust Avenue south of Dickson Street; and
