Approve the purchase of Spacesaver High Density Evidence Storage System

PROPOSAL:

The Fayetteville Police Department is in the process of becoming CALEA (Commission on Accreditation of Law Enforcement) certified. CALEA standards require extra security and handling for evidence items such as money, precious metals, jewelry, firearms and drugs.

The Fayetteville Police Department is seeking to accomplish this through a remodeling process that will incorporate an additional mobile shelving system purchased from Southwest Solutions Group. The Southwest Solutions Group handles the Spacesaver shelving system that is presently being utilized in the Property and Evidence Division. The new shelving will match the existing system and has a lock down function that requires a key before access for an additional level of security. The new shelving will provide adequate storage space for items requiring additional security and handling as listed above. Funding sources for this purchase is provided by the 2011 Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$3,656 and Internal Revenue Service Forfeitures in the amount of \$30,560.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the purchase and installation of a Spacesaver High Density Evidence Storage System from Southwest Solutions Group in an amount not to exceed \$34,216 including tax per the National Joint Powers Alliance Purchasing Contract.


