A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT JASON TAYLOR AND ALAN HARRISON AS SUCCESSOR COMMISSIONERS FOR FAYETTEVILE MUNICIPAL PROPERTY OWNERS' IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 19 – OAKBROOKE, PHASE 1 SUBDIVISION INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT
