Subject: Law Enforcement State and Federal Forfeitures for Fayetteville Police Department

#### PROPOSAL:

The Fayetteville Police Department receives forfeitures as a result of civil proceedings concerning cash or property seized during a criminal investigation. Most of the forfeitures we have received in the past are a direct result from the efforts of the officers we assign to the 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Drug Task Force (4<sup>th</sup> DTF), the IRS Task Force, and the local office of the Federal Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA). Use of federal forfeiture funds must adhere to the Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies. Use of state forfeiture funds must be used for law enforcement purposes. All purchases utilizing these funds will follow the City of Fayetteville Purchasing Policy.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of a budget adjustment to recognize state and federal forfeiture revenue received during the first quarter 2012 and establish expense budget in the total amount of \$43,366.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

Increase expenses to correspond with state and federal forfeiture revenue received during first quarter 2012.
