Subject:	Bid Waiver for Light Poles & Fixtures

PROPOSAL:

Staff proposes an ordinance waiving the requirements of formal competitive bidding for the purchase of light poles and fixtures needed to complete the improvements project currently under construction in downtown Fayetteville, including Mountain Street, College Avenue, Center Street, East Avenue, and Meadow Street.

<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u>

In order to remain consistent with the existing light poles and fixtures in the downtown area, the purchase of materials manufactured by Dynamic Lighting, Inc. and distributed by Amerlux Exterior, LLC will be necessary.

Staff recommends waiving the requirements of formal competitive bidding and approving the purchase of 17 Dynamic Lighting, Inc. poles and fixtures from Amerlux Exterior, LLC for a unit price of \$1,530.00 and a total purchase amount of \$26,010.00, plus sales tax.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funds for the acquisition of light poles and fixtures are budgeted in the Sidewalk Improvements capital project.
